9) Here you will see several options. The "Speakers" slider should be all the way toward the right and you will see "100" in the dialog box. The icon to the right is the mute (shown in its un muted state). If your Streamer has an LED on its input panel, verify that its state matches the one shown in the "Properties" dialog. If it is out of sync (Streamer shows muted, computer shows un muted) you can accomplish a resynchronization by first left clicking on the speaker icon, it will now show muted and the LED (if present) will be illuminated on the Streamer. Next left click once again and both the Streamer and the computer will be un muted. The two will remain in sync until unpaired. When you are ready, left click on the "Enhancements" tab
